Re: Matter No.1212-40 SCAQMD v. City of Los Angeles (Hyperion Water Treatment Plant) – Abatement Order Expiration –8/4/2025

Honorable Chairperson Micah Ali and Board Members,

As you are aware, the Hyperion abatement order was discussed in detail on November 19, 2024. It was our assumption and understanding that this matter would be agendaized and come again before the hearing board on August 4, 2025. Regrettably and to our disappointment, this item has not been agendaized at this point. Thus, we are requesting that the Board hear this item once again for an update.

The City of El Segundo has submitted prior letters to the Hearing Board regarding this matter and is once again writing to express our continued concerns with the ongoing health and odor issues created by the City of Los Angeles' failures to properly maintain and operate the Hyperion facility. Elected City Officials, Residents, and City Staff voiced these concerns during the Abatement Order Modification Hearing on November 19, 2024.

We are respectfully requesting the Board to agendaize this matter prior to expiration on August 4, 2025. We would like to confirm the compliance status of the conditions listed within the order. This continued oversight request is critical to the ongoing health and safety of our community and the regulatory and environmental compliance of the facility.

Since the last abatement order modification hearing, there have been approximately 10 notices of violation issued by your agency to the facility.


