

## Why recycle?

- **State law now requires that apartment communities/multi-family housing with 5 or more units and businesses that generate 4 or more cubic yards of waste weekly must recycle.**
- Recycling may provide opportunities to save money.
- Recycling helps conserve resources and also helps create a healthy environment for our community and future generations.
- Many apartment residents are requesting recycling. Providing recycling helps promote your community as environmentally friendly and may help fill vacancies.

## How to get started

It's easy to recycle.

- Make sure your business or multifamily complex has arranged for recycling services.
- Make sure residents or employees separate recyclable items from trash and place in appropriate containers.
- **Note:** Any business or individual may donate, sell and/or otherwise arrange for the pickup of recyclable materials.
